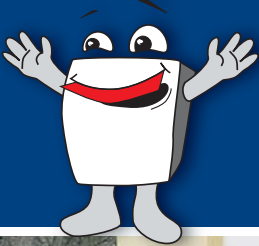

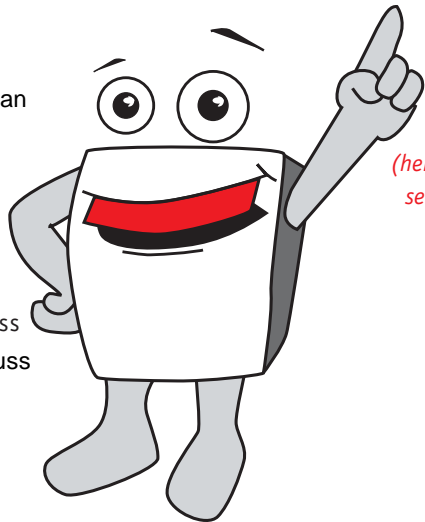


Multi-unit mailboxes have to fulfill several expectations. First and foremost is function: the delivered mail has to be kept secure and dry. Larger parcels should fit well. This is regulated by the EN 13724. If there is less space, smaller mailboxes must be used. But, regardless of the size, quality and security come first. Other important selection criteria are stability, durability and longevity. Because mailboxes are installed in the entrance area, the design must be convincing. And last but not least, the boxes should provide value for money.

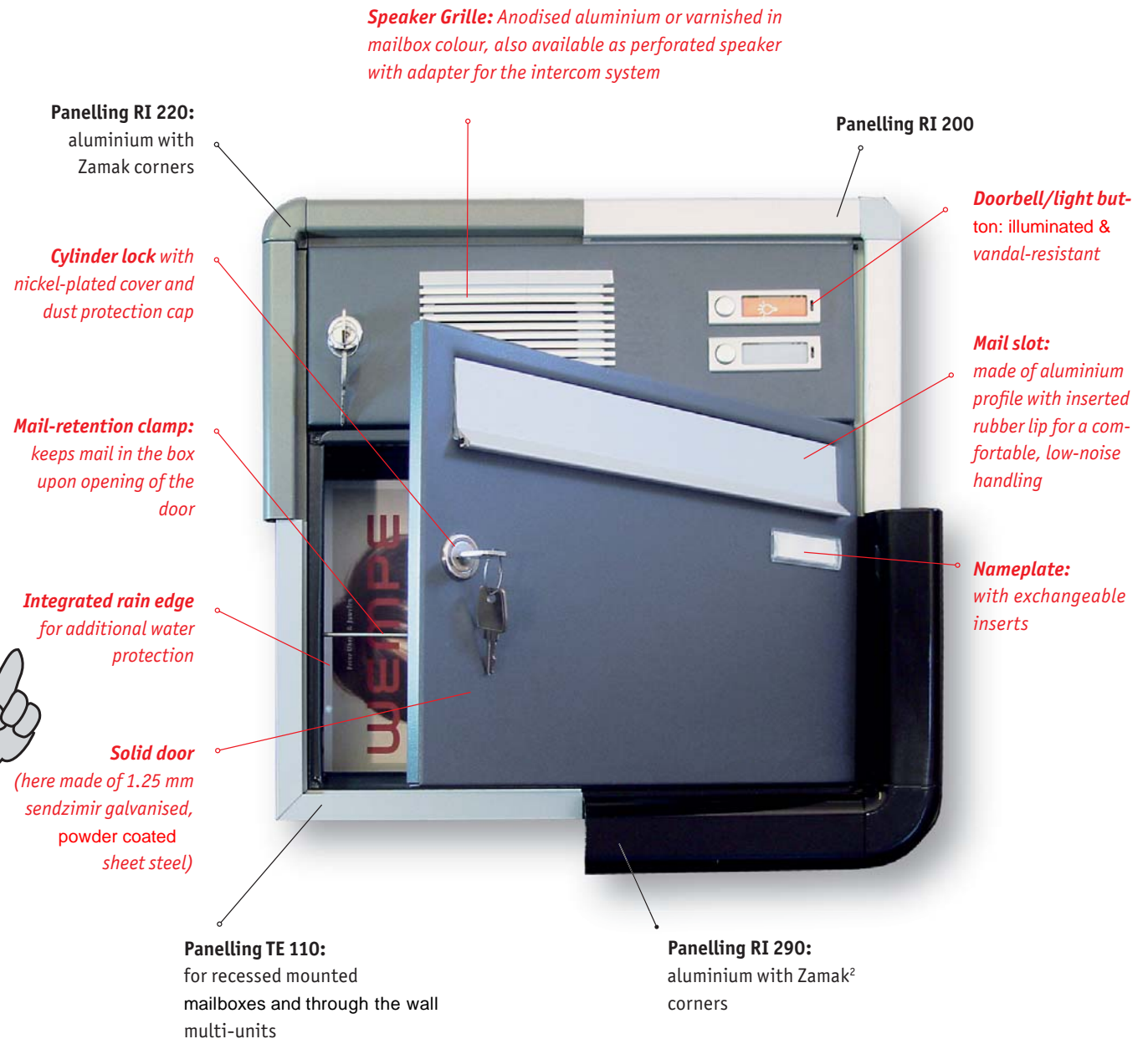

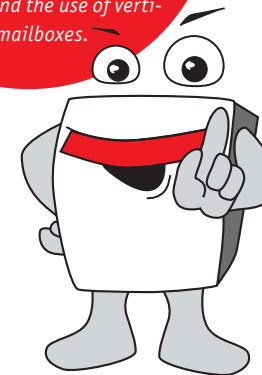

Here's a tip:
Please note that surface mounted multi-units with horizontal mailboxes can be up to 380 mm deep and because of this they could constrict driveways and footpaths, especially in stairways. In this case we recommend the use of vertical mailboxes.

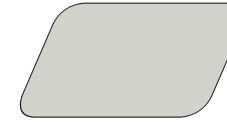

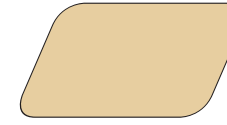

Product Care Tips

Please regularly clean all products, especially stainless steel products exposed to dirt or aggressive environmental influences (i.e. saline air). Only in this way is a long lifetime guaranteed. The powder coated surfaces as well as the stainless steel and anodised aluminium surfaces should be cleaned with warm water and washing-up liquid. Stainless steel components can also be treated with customary stainless steel cleaning agent. Please don't use any mechanically acting or oxide dissolving cleaning products. These corrode the anodised coating and destroy the surfaces. Door and lock hinges should be treated with a special cleaning agent, at least twice a year.

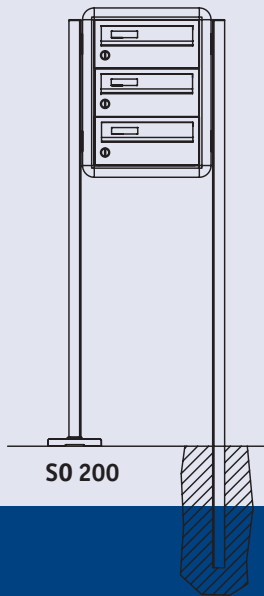
